INSTRUCTION TO CANDIDATES

- 1. Candidates should sit in their places in the Examination Hall at least **15 minutes before the time** fixed for the commencement of Examination. A candidate coming half an hour late after appointed time shall not be admitted.
- 2. Candidates shall not be allowed to leave the Examination Hall beforehalf an hour after the starting of examination and also before half an hour prior to the completion of the Examination and a candidate who leaves the room during the period allotted for paper shall notbe allowed to write the examination again.
- 3. Candidates are prohibited from writing their names in any part of their Answer Book.
- 4. Registration Number of the candidate must be written **distinctly and correctly**in the space provided for it on cover page and mark **appropriatecircle in OMR**. *Failure to write& mark in OMR, the Registration Number as specified above, will involve in rejection of Answer Bookincluding penalty*. Registration Number should not be written in any other part of Answer Book.
- 5. Candidates should have with them on all days of Examination, their Admission Card for inspection by Room Superintendent.
- 6. Candidates must read instructions printed on Answer Books carefully and follow them scrupulously.
- 7. Candidates are required to write their answers either with **Blue or Black** Ball point pen or similar ink pen.
